-Rus Berlin: What is the feeling about the school in the community? SLO: Transportation will always be an issue. With intl contracts, there are a lot of view of how behavior should be handled. Communication is better, parents are getting responses (10-fold improvement).

- It is a positive indicator that there is a waiting list. We do not get staffing for international (space available) students. Approval comes from the DSO. This can also affect things like ESOL, SPED.

-Financial readiness coming in for 3-5 grades. Three coming to do presentations, and also Red Ribbon Week.
